	Literacy leaves: 'The Good Thieves' by Katherine Rundell. This Literary Leaf begins with children exploring the 1920s in New York City - the time and place this book is set. They will develop their understanding of the period and explore the issues of the day as well as any relevant vocabulary. Children will gain experience of answering a range of inference questions, focussing on impressions, character's feelings, relationships and motivation. They will also explore how protagonists change over time by mapping out character arcs.
